Linda Farmer Research Award 2022

Applications for the Linda Farmer Research Award are now being accepted for funding consideration. The 2022 Linda Farmer Research Award offers \$2,500 to a Rosenstiel School undergraduate in good standing pursuing a B.S. degree in the marine sciences at Rosenstiel School. Funds can be requested for (1) materials and supplies that support substantive research activities, (2) the costs of field work or visits to archives related to independent research, and (3) attendance at scientific meetings or conferences where original work is being presented. Funding decisions will be made by a subcommittee of the Rosenstiel School faculty with final approval by the Program Directors and Associate Dean. This committee adheres to a broad definition of research "research or scholarly activities that lead to the production of new knowledge."

You are eligible to apply for the Linda Farmer Research Award if you are:

- 1. A Rosenstiel School undergraduate student, including freshmen, pursuing a B.S. degree;
- 2. Enrolled during the semester of your grant award;
- 3. In good academic standing (not on probation, leave of absence, or suspension).

How do I apply?

An application consists of the following:

- 1. A short research proposal (max two pages) with a clear statement of purpose and a summary of the research or activities to be conducted; the statement should identify your research mentor or supervisor;
- 2. An itemized budget, including total costs above what the Linda Farmer Award offers and disclosure of any other available support;
- 3. A standard résumé (max two pages);
- 4. A letter of support from your advisor or faculty research mentor. This letter, addressed to the Rosenstiel School Undergraduate Program Awards Committee, must be sent separately by your advisor/mentor.

Please indicate which award you are applying for (SURGE, Farmer, and /or Mastriani). You may apply to all three with one application. Your choice of award category should be indicated in the email that accompanies your application.

Please submit your application as a single pdf document by using the naming convention (comprised of your last name): Lastname_Awards2022.pdf. Your faculty advisor/mentor should title their recommendation letter as: "Student's Lastname_Recommendation_Awards2022.pdf." All applications and recommendation letters should be submitted to Ruth Goodin by email to ruthgoodin@miami.edu.

What are the Grant Requirements?

By accepting the Linda Farmer Award, you agree to:

- 1. Write a thank you note (postal mail) to the Linda Farmer Endowment with details about your research. This will be expected within one week of receiving this award;
- 2. Present your work at the annual Rosenstiel School Undergraduate Research Poster Symposium scheduled for April 2023 (date TBD);
- 3. Provide a written assessment of your activities and an accounting of how funds were spent;
- 4. Follow animal or human subject protocols, if applicable.

Failure to satisfy these requirements will result in ineligibility for future awards.
